

OUR IMPACT: FARM EDUCATION



With a team of three full-time, expert educators, the Farm welcomed 1,355 students in FY19 for hands-on, STEM-based curricular experiences. Scholarships and transportation support was provided to low-income, Title-1 and Title-V schools, ensuring access to quality educational opportunities, regardless of ability to pay. Through their visits, students gain deeper understandings of the food system, environmental stewardship, and more. Teacher feedback:

- 95% said that the visit reinforced learning objectives
- 87% reported that the visit fostered interest in nature and the environment
- 92% indicated that the visit was highly positive
- 100% said that they would recommend the visit to a colleague

The Great Outdoor Shabbat summer series welcomed 700 community members, with 91% sharing that the Farm provides them with opportunities to express their Jewish identities and inspires them to be more active in Jewish life.

The Farm produces nutrient-dense food using sustainable methods that maintain diverse and rich ecosystems.

- Pay-What-You-Can Farm Stand No-cost mobile farm stands at Camp
- Pendleton and Vista Community Clinic Holocaust Survivors program
- Distributions to low-income seniors. food banks, and emergency food partners
