About the Farm

Coastal Roots Farm is a nonprofit Jewish community farm and education center where we practice organic regenerative farming, share our harvest with those who lack access, deliver unique farm-based environmental education, and foster inclusive spaces for people of all ages and backgrounds to come together to learn about food, farming, and Jewish tradition, and engage in ways that catalyze a healthier, more vibrant community and a more sustainable future for our region. The Farm is located in Encinitas, California, on land we recognize as indigenous to the Kumeyaay and Luiseño peoples.

Each year, the Farm grows 80,000 pounds of fresh organic food for more than 45,000 people of which we donate over 70% to community members in need. Additionally, we reach more than 15,000 community members through programs and events. This is how we "Nourish Community."

About the Farm Film and Music Series

The 2023 Farm Film and Music Series will showcase films including <u>To Which We Belong</u>, <u>The Blue Forest</u>, <u>Rooted</u>, <u>Fish People</u>, and <u>Tribal Waters</u>; invite dialogue around themes of climate hope, Tribal sovereignty, ocean conservation, regenerative agriculture, and food equity; highlight local nonprofit partners doing work to serve both people and planet; and feature local musicians. Guests bring their own picnic dinner and a curious mind as they gather in community with shared values and commitment to a healthy ecosystem.
